The Association of American Seed Control Officials (AASCO) is currently accepting applications for travel assistance funding. AASCO funds may be awarded to qualifying members with the intention of providing monetary assistance to individual seed control officials interested in attending the Federal Seed Act Training Program scheduled for December 6-7, 2011.

AASCO was organized in 1949 for purposes of discussion of mutual problems and concerns relating to seed law enforcement and administration. It is the goal of AASCO to achieve uniformity of seed legislation between member states and Federal agencies through consensus of the membership. These goals are achieved through these discussions with our Federal partners.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must be an AASCO member in good standing both nationally and regionally (*Annual dues paid in full*).
2. Have not received AASCO travel assistance in the past 2 years.
